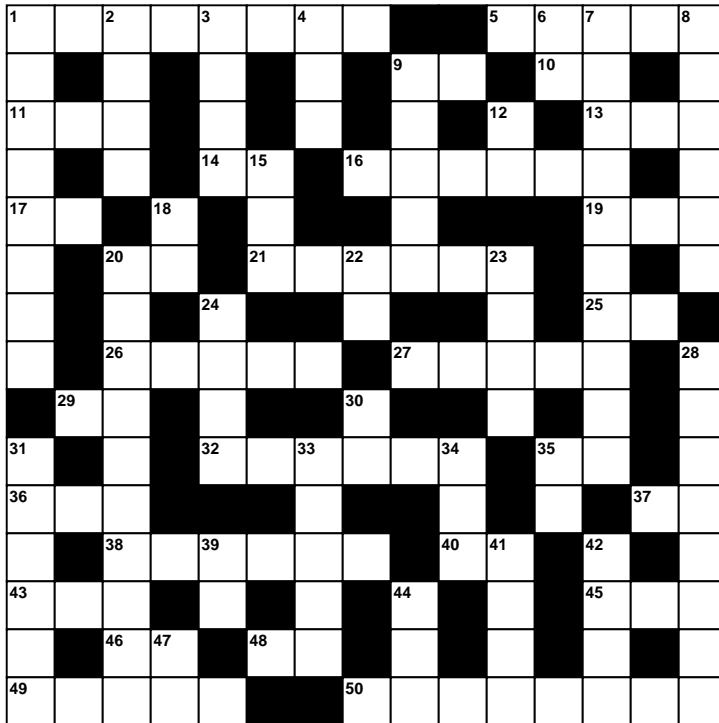


Women Governors



ACROSS

- 1 Became second female governor of Washington in 2005
- 5 Became governor of Vermont in 1985 and served for six years
- 9 Abbreviation for commonwealth in 26 across
- 10 Gov. Miriam Amanda Ferguson, nicknamed "Ma", was married to a former governor of Texas; he was nicknamed this
- 11 In the two party system in the US, elections are "winner takes ___"
- 13 Abbreviation for person who goes into politics
- 14 Abbreviation for 31 down
- 16 Governor of Louisiana who took office in 2004
- 17 Abbreviation for the state where 27 across is governor
- 19 Given upon arrival in the state referenced in 27 across
- 20 In 1925, this was the first state in the US to have a female governor
- 21 Governor of Delaware elected in 2000 and re-elected in 2004
- 25 State that first elected a woman to be governor, Miriam Amanda Ferguson, in 1924, however another woman (8 down) took office first in 1925
- 26 First name of first woman to be

- governor of Puerto Rico
- 27 First name of first woman to be governor of the Aloha state
- 29 Abbreviation for the state in 49 across
- 32 Dina Titus ran for governor in this state in 2006
- 35 Harriett Woods became lieutenant governor of this state in 1985
- 36 What women must do to become governors
- 37 Jeanne Shaheen became governor of this state in 1997 and served for six years
- 38 Elected in 1974, first woman to become governor who was not married to a former governor
- 40 Christine Todd Whitman became governor of this state in 1994
- 43 First word in acronym GOTV, needed to win any gubernatorial election
- 45 Governor of Nebraska beginning in 1987
- 46 Preposition beginning the phrase "the ballot for election"
- 48 State where Jane Swift was acting governor from 2001 to 2003
- 49 First name of first woman to be governor of Ohio, she served on an interim basis
- 50 Governor of Kansas elected in 2002 and re-elected in 2006

- 1 This woman, born in Canada, became governor of a state bordering Canada in 2003
- 2 First name of 38 across, she was governor in Connecticut
- 3 State of Governor Hollister
- 4 First woman to be governor of Washington, from 1977 - 1981
- 6 Preposition beginning the phrase "for re-election"
- 7 Governor of Arizona elected in 2002 and re-elected in 2006
- 8 First name of first woman to become governor in the US
- 9 First woman to be governor of Alaska, elected in 2006
- 12 Katherine Davis was the first female lieutenant governor here, nicknamed the "Hoosier" state
- 15 Initials of 21 across
- 18 Thelma Stovall was the first female lieutenant governor in this "Bluegrass" state
- 20 First state to have women fill the governor's office and both US Senate seats at the same time
- 22 Mary Anne Krupsak was the first female lieutenant governor here, nicknamed the "Empire" state
- 23 Where you throw your hat when you announce your candidacy
- 24 Needed for a winning campaign
- 28 Keynote speaker at 1988 Democratic Convention and later governor of Texas
- 30 Dianne Feinstein ran for governor here before being elected to the US Senate
- 31 In 1991, Barbara Roberts became its first female governor
- 33 First name of first female governor of New Hampshire, she served as acting governor
- 34 First name of 28 down
- 35 State for governor in 1 down
- 39 Lurleen Wallace became governor of this state in 1967
- 41 First name of second woman to be governor of Arizona
- 42 Common name of woman who became governor of Connecticut in 2004
- 44 Middle name of first woman to be governor of Washington state
- 47 Beverly Perdue became the first female lieutenant governor of this state in 2001
